


# THE INTER-CULTURAL FRAMEWORK

**The Red Space** serves to teach others about culture. The Intent and Purpose of this space is to transfer knowledge about culture.

**The Yellow Space** serves to foster pragmatic work alongside each other's culture. The Purpose and Intent of this space is to gain enough knowledge and respect to work efficiently and effectively together.

**The Green Space** serves to cultivate innovation in practice and ideas for cultures to work together. The Intent and Purpose of this space is to challenge current convention and explore new ideas, options and practices.

Working through these spaces, it is possible to improve your understanding of cultural dynamics at team, organisation and stakeholder levels.

It can be applied to various forms of difference and cultural expression.
